White Grenache, Maccabee, Viognier, Pedro Ximénez.



Vineyards over 40 years old, located in Gratallops.

Licorella (Slate of the Carboniferous period).



The different varieties of this wine are collected at their optimum ripening point, they are fermented separately, at an initial temperature of 14 °C, this fermentation is carried out in French oak barrels, starting bâtonnage process (stir up the lees). After aging for six months, we proceed with bottling.



Dry white wine, fruity and floral aromas in combination with a wide and structured palate. Its complexity demonstrates its remarkable personality. With a mineral background, ripe, unctuous and fleshy in mouth.



Between 13° alch. vol. and 14° alch.vol.



Between 10 °C and 14 °C and up to 10 years after harvest.



Fruity, tropical, mature, unctuous and fleshy wine. Can be combined with all types of fish, and especially with seafood. Also with white meat and vegetables. Suitable for desserts with moderate sweetness such as puddings, quince and natural fruit. Perfect to enjoy by the glass too.
