90% Grenache and Carignan; 10% Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Syrah.

Slate (Slate of the Carboniferous period).



Grenache and Carignan from 100-year-old vineyards. Cabernet Sauvignon from vineyards between 20 and 25 years old, Syrah and Merlot from vineyards between 15 and 20 years old. All in the municipalities of Bellmunt del Priorat, La Vilella Baixa, Gratallops, Falset and El Molar.



Each variety is fermented separately. The maceration is long and takes place at a temperature between 26 °C and 28 °C. Subsequently, malolactic fermentation takes place. Once finished, it is aged in French oak barrels for about 10-14 months, depending on the vintage. It is blended, bottled and aged in the bottle for a minimum of 6-8 months.



Dry and complex red wine due to the combination of aromas extracted from the grapes of the barrels. With an amazing aromatic power.

Between 16 °C and 19 °C. Wine for aging. We recommend decanting it before serving.



Very elegant wine, mineral, grenache / sweet and with structure. Can be combined with both meat and fish, salads with berries, jams and soy. Also with non-citrus desserts and rather sweets such as nougat, coulants, etc.
