Clean and deep ruby colour. Intense, red and black fruit flavors in balance with its background layers of soft spicy and toasty notes. Long finish.



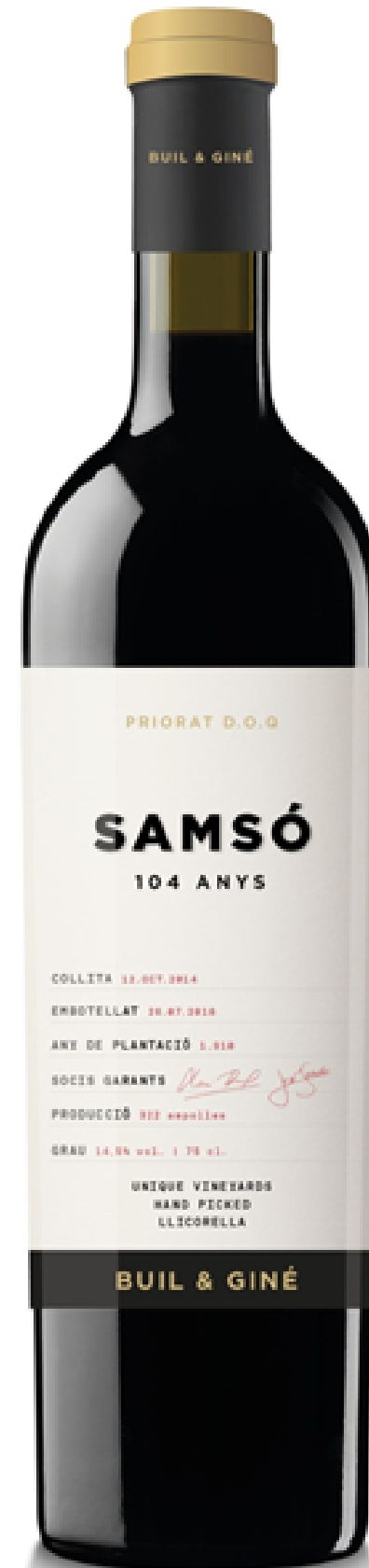
