White Grenache (70%), Macabeu (20%), Viognier and Pedro Ximénez (10%).



Vineyards over 40 years old, located in Gratallops. Licorella (Slate of the Carboniferous period).



The different varieties of this wine are collected at their optimum ripening point. The varieties are fermented separately, at an initial controlled temperature of 14 °C, in new French oak barrels. The wine is kept in the same casks for a short ageing of six months on its lees, practicing bâtonnage. After ageing the wine is bottled and stored for at least two years before being released.



Bright straw-yellow colour. On the nose, aromas of fresh citrus fruits and white flowers. Very expressive at taste, showing flavours of stone fruits such as pear and peach, lemon flavours and tropical fruits such as Litchi; honeysuckle, chamomile, and a hint of ginger adds subtle spiciness. With a mineral background, ripe, unctuous and fleshy in mouth. A very intense wine of remarkable personality, with volume and vibrant acidity, and a wide and structured palate.

Between 10 °C and 14 °C and up to 10 years after harvest.



Can be combined with all types of fish, and especially with seafood. Also with white meat and vegetables. Suitable for desserts with moderate sweetness such as puddings, quince and natural fruit. Perfect to enjoy by the glass too.
